Appropriation

To appropriate is to take possession of something. Appropriation artists deliberately copy images to take possession of them in their art.

Manga (Hokusai)

A book of whimsical sketches by Japanese artist Hokusai

Manga

A Japanese graphic novel form

Recontextualization

The deliberate "borrowing" of an image to alter it while conserving the original meaning and the viewer's association with the original image or the real thing.

Ukiyo-e

18th and 19th century Japanese print form created in woodblock technique

Woodblock print

Created on a block of wood; image is cut out in relief, inked, and printed by pressing a sheet of paper on block of wood
